

A draft Heritage Strategy for the district has been produced by the Council, and a six-week public consultation period will run from 30 July until 10 September 2018. The document sets out a positive strategy for managing the conservation and enhancement of the district's historic environment, which will help inform the Council's emerging Local Plan.

The district's archaeology, historic buildings and landscapes are of national and international importance. The Strategy tries to help articulate why they are valued, looks at the ways in which they are vulnerable, as well as the opportunities for maximizing their value. The document makes a series of recommendations for taking the Strategy forward.
