#### Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July

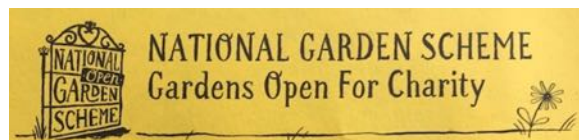
