Leighton Moss

Leighton Moss RSPB reserve has been in the care of the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds since 1964. Leighton Moss contains the largest area of reed beds in northwest England. The site provides habitats for many species of wildlife, including bitterns and red deer. As a wetland of international importance, it was designated a Ramsar site in 1985 and is a Site of Special Scientific Interest, a Special Protection Area, and an Important Bird Area.
